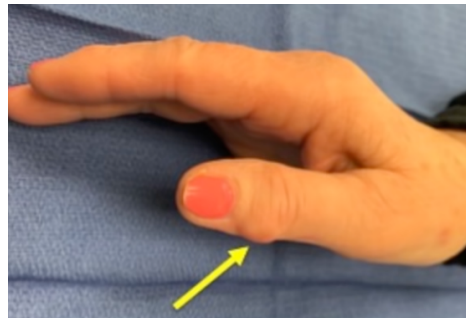

In this podcast, Dr. Larry Hurst takes you through details of Muroid cysts. Muroid cysts are benign solitary round to oval skin-colored lesions, also referred to as mucinous cysts or myxoid cysts. Muroid cysts commonly occur in women, usually on the dorsum of the DIP joint. The skin covering a cyst can be very thin, sometimes even translucent. Thus, minor trauma can cause the cyst to rupture and deflate with spontaneous drainage of a clear jelly-like material.
