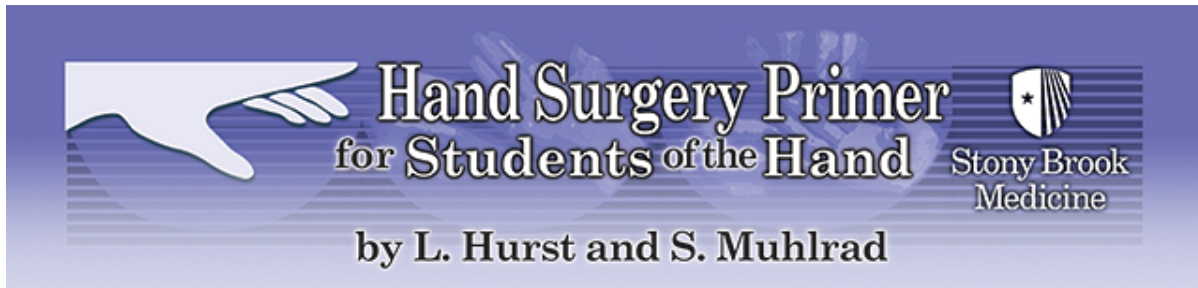

Hand Surgery Resources, LLC Releases Hand Surgery Primer Version 1.5

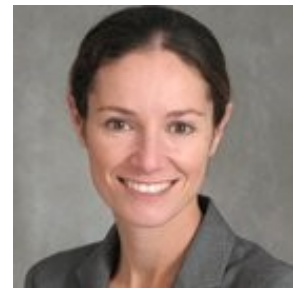
Version 1.5 is now available! Visit www.handsurgeryprimer.org to view our improvements, which include:
